Guidelines
First Semester classes must be completed prior to enrolling in Second Semester classes.
Second Semester classes must be completed prior to enrolling in Third Semester classes.
2.0 Overall average (on a 4.0 scale) required.
C or better required on articulated courses.
Program must be commenced within 2 years graduation.
Articulated credits may not transfer to other institutions.
Students may earn a maximum of four articulated, non-dual enrollment courses toward an Associate Degree or a maximum of two articulated, non-dual enrollment courses toward a Certificate Program.
Students interested in eventually pursuing an A.A.S. degree in Nursing should take Chemistry in high school.
Students may be required to demonstrate knowledge/skills on articulated courses.
