Guidelines
First Semester classes must be completed prior to enrolling in Second Semester classes.
Second Semester classes must be completed prior to enrolling in Third Semester classes.
2.0 Overall average (on a 4.0 scale) required.
C or better required on articulated courses.
Articulated credits may not transfer to other institutions.
Students must complete Keyboarding Applications prior to graduation. This is normally completed in the 7 <sup>th</sup> grade.
Program must be commenced within 2 years of graduation.
Students may be required to demonstrate knowledge/skills on articulated courses.
Students interested in eventually pursuing an A.A.S. degree in Nursing should take Chemistry in high school.
