Guidelines
Prior to NUR 111, NUR 120 & 135 is recommended.
NUR 111 has numerous pre-requisites. Go to <a href="http://www.sv.vccs.edu/acad/nurse/">http://www.sv.vccs.edu/acad/nurse/</a> for information.
Pre-requisites for NUR 221: NUR 111, NUR 136, NUR 226, STD 100, SOC 200 and NAS 161 with a “C” or better.
Pre-requisites for NUR 222: NUR 221, HLT 230, and NAS 162 with a “C” or better.
Pre-requisites for NUR 223: NUR 222, PSY 230, and ENG 111 with a “C” or better.
NUR 223, NUR 137 and NUR 254 are taken during final semester.
American Heart CPR required prior to NUR 111 & 115 classes.
Students may be required to demonstrate knowledge/skills on articulated courses.
Biology & Chemistry prerequisites. Must have at least a “C” in courses.
Articulated credits may not transfer to other institutions.
PAX-RN; AD Composite Score of 45 or above.
You must have a GPA of 2.5 or above at SVCC.
2.0 Overall average (on a 4.0 scale) required.
C or better required on articulated courses.

The following sequence of courses is recommended in order to minimize course load:

NAS 162-Health Sciences II: 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Year 1 instead of 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Year 1

ENG 112: Summer Year 1 instead of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Year 3

HUM EEE: Summer Year 1 instead of 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Year 2
